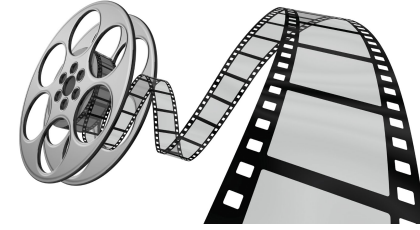


Androscoggin Film Festival



What is the best thing humans can do to ensure equilibrium in a region's ecosystem?

REQUIREMENTS :

- Create a documentary to educate others about the organism and their biome/region you have chosen.
- At least 5 but no more than 10 minutes long.
- Include a map to define your region - The range of your native organism and it's biome.
- Include at least 10-15 characteristics of your biome/region (animals, plants, landforms, climate, human impact, changes over time, location, food webs, abiotic features, symbiosis).
- Create and include at least one graph and/or chart that represents your biome/region (change over time, population growth, etc.)
- Include a title slide and end credits.
- Include works consulted at the end of your presentation (easybib.com, citationmachine.com) (Remember you have to cite both your sources, as well as images/videos you use).
- Your video should have a written or typed script (using a template) to go with it.
- Groups should be no more than 4 students and yes, you can work independently.
